Many St. John School Alumni and their parents will be reminded of their elementary school days when reading the following obituary which was in the Catholic Telegraph for January 8, 2010: 'Sister Stanislaus Poehnelt, a Sister of Mercy of the Holy Cross, died December 19th in Merrill, Wisconsin. She was 96. The Wisconsin native entered the religious life at the age of 15. She professed vows in 1933 and spent 77 years in ministry. Sister Stanislaus was a teacher and principal of St. John the Evangelist School in Deer Park from 1934-45, 1946-48, 1960-63, and was principal and superior from 1966-72.
