Wenke explained that because Fr. Pat Crone (St. Saviour) is retiring St. Saviour Parish will be 'open listed' to provide active priests the opportunity to apply as Pastor for the parish. This process will begin in February and we should know the outcome by April 2010 on whether the Region 11 plan for a shared pastor will go into effect July 1st, 2010 or if each parish will have one pastor for a few more years.
